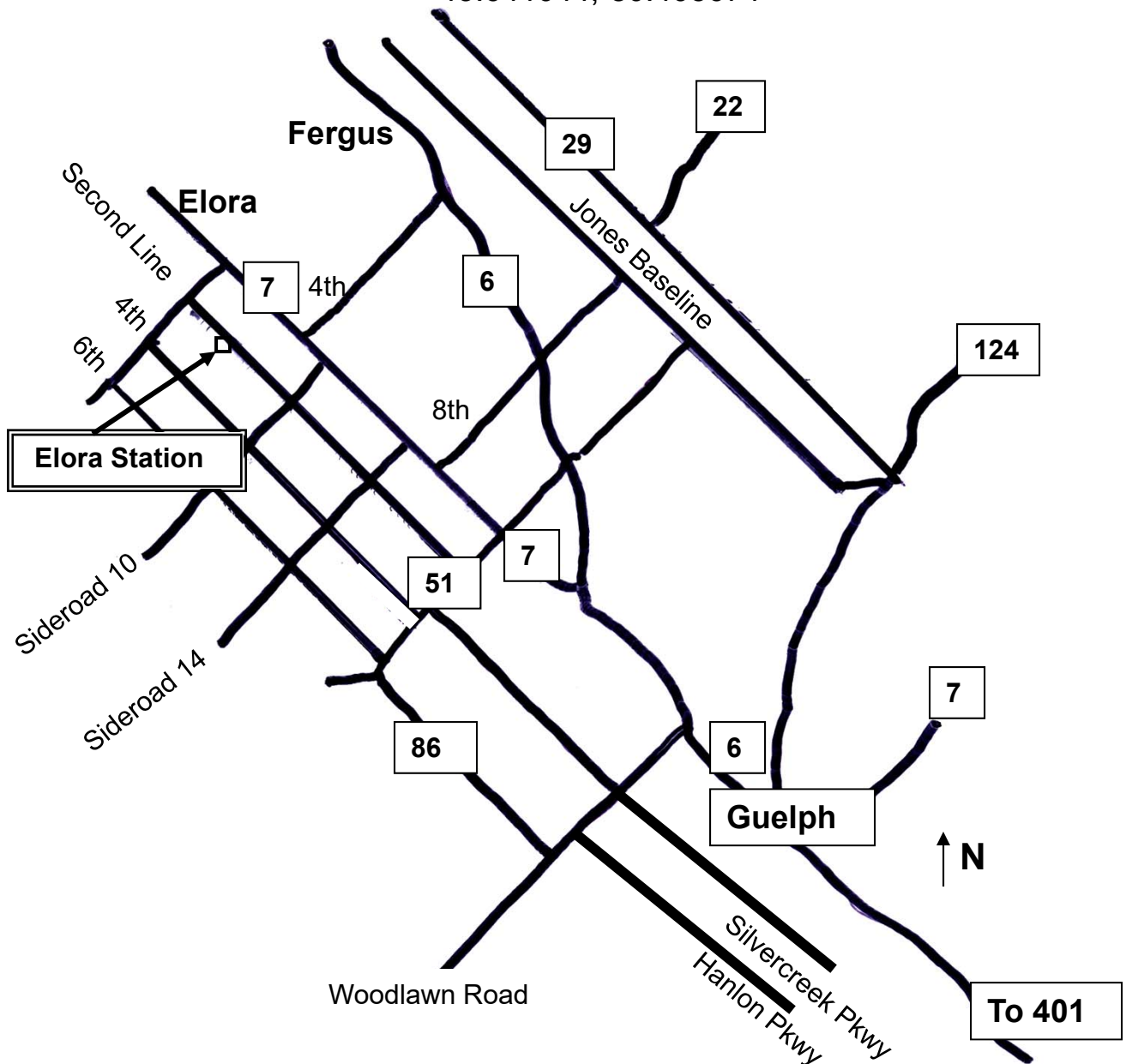

From Elora: take the Elora Road (Hwy 7) towards Guelph. Take the first right after “Webfoot Farms”. Take your first left. Drive past the beef station and the **Crops Building** is on your right.

From Guelph: Take Hwy 6 out of town. Pass Marden. Turn left on the road to Elora (Hwy 7). Take Wellington Road 7 for 7.8 km until you pass “Royal City Design” on your left. Take the next left at the bottom of the hill. Then turn right at the first intersection. The **Crops Building** will be on your left.
